SOS for Higher Ed: Suicide Prevention for Faculty & Staff is a 30-minute, self-guided online training designed to prepare employees to respond to signs of distress in students. Using the ACT (Acknowledge, Care, Tell) framework, the training shares hands-on practice scenarios and campus staff who have real experience supporting students at risk for suicide.

Developed by the creators of the evidence-based SOS Signs of Suicide, our Higher Ed trainings carry SOS from middle and high schools onto campuses at a time when mental health concerns often first appear. This makes college and university campuses an ideal place to educate and reinforce suicide prevention practices for everyone.

- Know how to keep a student safe while connecting them to appropriate supports
